Tate International's Online Offering

Our vision is to provide an enriched and stimulating education that gives the opportunity for all-rounded learning online and caters for the individuality and uniqueness of each child.

What does this all mean?

Basically, we believe that when we play we are happy and when we are happy we learn.

As we are witnessing a huge revolution in the education sector all over the world at the moment, we believe it is our duty, as educators, to prepare the next generation for the demands of the competitive world that awaits them. We can see that the traditional method of teaching and school, as we know it, is very quickly becoming obsolete. Our children need to be taught to analyse, interpret and apply new information in such a way that shows initiative, critical thinking and innovation.

Tate International's philosophy is one of consciously changing the traditional way of educating children in South Africa. Our approach is not one of remembering facts, writing tests and getting full marks. It is more about enjoying the journey of learning and discovering. We are preparing our children for careers that do not exist yet, therefore, critical analysis, slowing down the process of learning, understanding concepts at their own individual pace and applying these skills, are imperative for their future.

The current education system does not cater for this generation of children, as it expects them to show their knowledge in ways that are outdated and does not give a true reflection of their brilliance. It simply does not prepare them for the world that awaits them. We believe the way we teach children and assess them has to completely change. It has to speak to them in their digital language and we believe we have created this.

How does this all work?

Through the expertise of our educating body we have transferred our full curriculum onto our online platform, Tate World. This prepares students to write the Cambridge International GCSE and AS Levels, but they would also be very able to write any exit exam in Grade 12, such as the NSC or GED.

Our educator team has designed and developed teaching outcomes that meets the criteria required for each subject in each grade. These are integrated in our online academic offering.

There are two components to a lesson plan.

Component 1: The Teaching Part.

Each lesson has four parts to component 1:

- a) Engage: This part of the lesson engages and introduces the student to the topic, skill or concept that will be taught. This is where the objective of the lesson is shared.
- b) Explore: In this part of the lesson students independently view video content to understand the topic or skill better.
- c) Explain: This is the teaching component where new or interesting information is shared and the understanding part of the topic or skill takes place.
- d) Elaborate: In this section students practice skills and extend their thinking. The elaborate section helps the student to develop a deeper understanding about the topic, skills or concept.

Component 2: The Assessment Part.

It is in this component that the students become completely immersed in practicing the skill or objective that they have been taught and are able to repeat it until they have achieved it. Through this gamification component, failure in this aspect is just an opportunity to try again in a safe environment where confidence is built rather than broken down. As the student practices, Tate coins are earned to encourage him/her to keep trying until the required level is achieved.
